



City of Hanford Mattress Drop-Off Procedure

The City of Hanford and the Mattress Recycling Council (MRC) have agreed to partner to give residents and businesses within city limits the opportunity to sustainably recycle their unwanted mattresses, box springs, and futons, all while reducing the amount of waste contributed to landfills and discouraging the incidence of illegal dumping. The City of Hanford has set up a drop-off location located at 900 S. 10th Ave for city residents and city businesses to drop off unwanted mattresses every **WEDNESDAY from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm and every 3rd SATURDAY of each month from 7:30 am to 12:00 pm** free of charge.

1. Residents and businesses of the City of Hanford must provide proof of residency for verification purposes. Acceptable documentation includes but is not limited to a government-issued photo ID (e.g., driver's license or state ID), utility bill (e.g., water, electricity, or gas), phone bill, or other official document confirming City of Hanford home residency. These documents must be presented for verification by City staff at the front office of the Public Works Corporation Yard.
2. City employees will direct customers to a designated area to unload mattress(s).
3. City employees are prohibited from removing mattress(s) from non-city vehicles.
4. Customers must fill out a mattress program sheet for records.
 - A. Name of Customer & Signature
 - B. Address
 - C. Quantity of mattresses (10 max per vehicle, per visit)
 - D. Type of mattress(s)- Mattress, box spring, or futon (NO BED FRAME or TOPPERS).
5. City employee(s) will load mattress(s) with the assistance of a forklift into a dry-van trailer provided by (MRC)
6. **ALL MATTRESSES, BOX SPRINGS, AND FUTONS WILL BE INSPECTED BY CITY STAFF. IF DETERMINED THE ITEMS ARE UNACCEPTABLE, THE CITY WILL REQUIRE THAT THE CUSTOMER MAINTAINS POSSESSION OF THE REFUSED ITEMS.**
7. **SOILED, HEAVILY DAMAGED, OR ITEMS INFESTED WITH BED BUGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
